

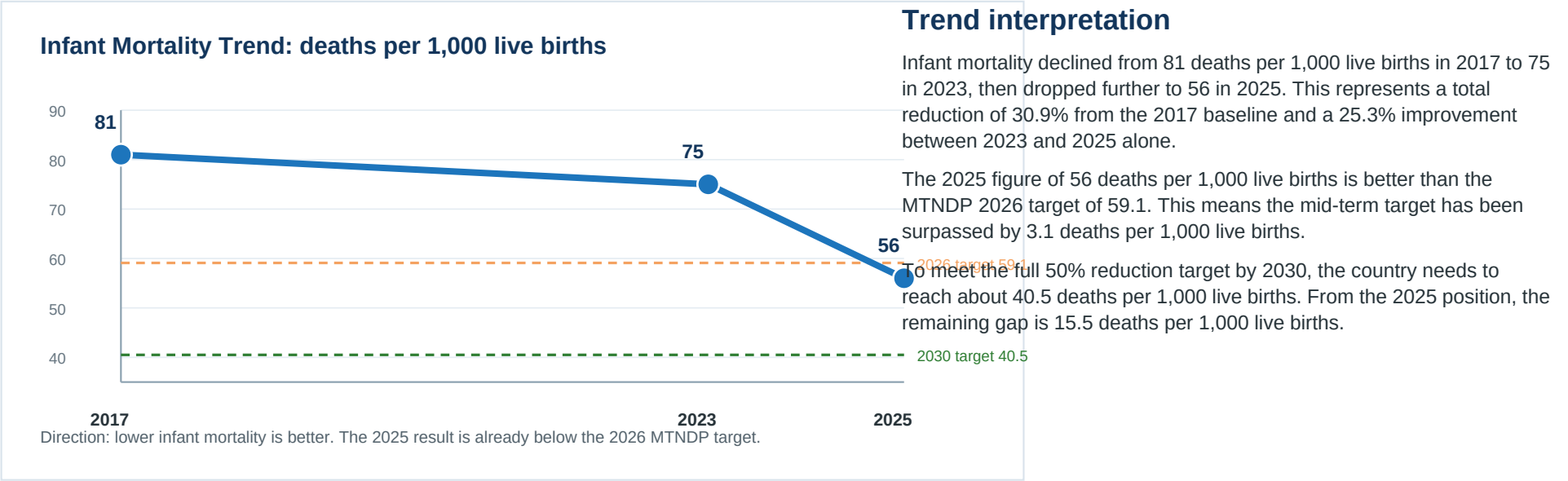
HEALTH SCORECARD TREND ANALYSIS
