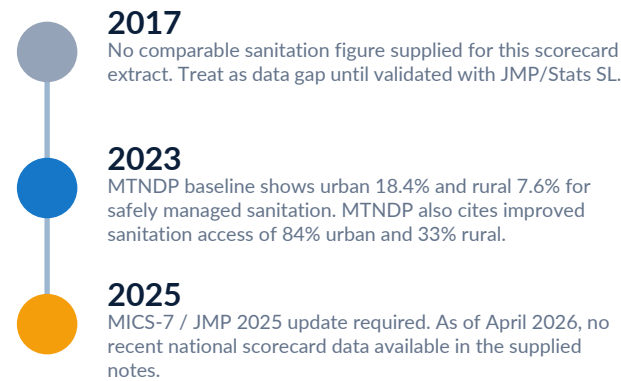
Water and Sanitation: Safely Managed Sanitation Trend Review, Sierra Leone

Technical notes for IGR scorecard use

Year	Indicator status	Urban	Rural	Scorecard interpretation
2017	Comparable data not supplied	-	-	Do not calculate trend without a verified JMP or Stats SL value for the same indicator definition.
2023	Baseline reference available	18.4% safely managed; 84% improved sanitation	7.6% safely managed; 33% improved sanitation	Baseline shows urban advantage and rural service gap. Keep safely managed and improved sanitation as separate measures.
2025	Update pending	MICS-7 / JMP pending	MICS-7 / JMP pending	Use Data Pending / Not Rated until the updated survey or JMP estimate is available.

Rating rule

Rate only when the same indicator definition, same population split and comparable year values are available. Avoid scoring improved sanitation as safely managed sanitation.

Priority evidence needed

Request updated MICS-7 tables, JMP country file and administrative infrastructure delivery data for 2024-2025.

Suggested visual status

Use amber status: Data Pending. Include a footnote that latest comparable WASH data was not available as of April 2026.
